

BIRD SURVEY – Point Counts

Do **two** bird surveys: 1) in **April 17 to April 23** and 2) in **May 15 to May 21**.

Survey in morning from 6:00-11:00. Finish before 11:00 am.

Study Site:

Weather should be clear and calm. Pick an earlier time on another day if it is raining, windy, or noisy. Earlier is better.

Date:

For a total of 6 minutes:

Count number of each species seen and heard within a 20 m radius.

Observer(s):

Count number of each species seen and heard outside a 20 m radius.

Survey points **a** and **b** (the ends of your study site) on the same morning.

Time between finishing **a** and beginning **b** must be <10 minutes.

Do not count individual birds twice (if counted at **a**, do not count again or at **b**).
