

**BIRD SURVEY – Point Counts**

Do two bird surveys: 1) in October 22-29 and 2) in November 11-18.

Survey in morning from 6:00-11:00. Finish by 11:00 am.

Study Site:

Weather should be clear and calm. Pick an earlier time on another day if it is raining, windy, or noisy.

Date:

Survey points A and B (the ends of your study site) on the same morning.

For a total of 6 minutes:

Observer(s):

Count number of species seen and heard within a 20 m radius.

Count number of each species seen and heard outside a 20 m radius.

Make sure time between finishing A and beginning B is <10 minutes.

Do not count individual birds twice (if counted at A, do not count at B).
